- 2. Never ridicule or yell at the children for making mistakes or losing a game.
- 3. Provide positive feedback, avoiding negative comments and punishment.
- 4. Where practical rotate players evenly on court throughout the minor round.
- 5. Develop team respect for the ability of players within your own team, the opposition as well as for umpires/officials.

- 6. Be a positive role model for your players and the sport.
- 7. Make a personal commitment to keep yourself informed on sound coaching principles and with the rules of the game, constitution and by-laws.
