- 1. Remember, children play sports for their enjoyment, not yours.
- 2. Encourage children to participate and do their best, but do not force them.
- 3. Encourage your child to play by the rules.
- 4. Be positive, Supportive and Encourage your child and their teammates.
- 5. Never ridicule or yell at the children for making mistakes or losing a game.
- 6. Remember that children learn best by example. Applaud good performance and focus on the efforts by your team AND the opponents rather than the overall game's outcome.

- 7. Respect the official's decision. If you disagree with an official; raise the issue through the appropriate channels rather than question the official's judgement.
- 8. Let the coach do the coaching. Provide positive reinforcement after training/games.
- 9. Thank our volunteer coaches, team managers and officials because without them your child would not be able to participate in netball.
