Our Under 14 team also went undefeated through out the season and managed to win one of the greatest finals you will see played. After bowling Walkerville out for just over 100 we were in trouble early and at one stage being 9/50. Luckily the captain Aidan Dwiar managed to steer his team home and get the win.
