

Hectorville Hurricanes Netball Club Trials Policy

Hectorville Netball Club is a grassroots community club offering a place for people of all skill levels to play netball. As a club we ensure that everyone is trialled fairly and placed in a team based on their attendance at trials, fitness, skill level and their commitment to training. This might mean that any expectations of being placed with friends or staying in current teams cannot be guaranteed.

Trials

The overarching aim of trials is to give selectors a chance to evaluate new and existing players to enable the formation of balanced teams (where all positions are covered) for the upcoming season. If you are unable to attend trials, you may be placed in a team below your skill level.

To participate in trials, you need to complete the online nomination form via 'Team App' or 'Play HQ' and pay the registration fee in full.

Trial format

Trials will be held for each age group in the aged category i.e. U9s, U11, U13s, U15s, U17s and opens/seniors (17 years and above). At the clubs discretion, we may ask players to come to a less formal trial so individual players can be assessed. Players can only trial within their age division to ensure players are fairly evaluated against their peers.

Trials will include a game evaluation and a skill evaluation (where applicable)



The number of players at trials fluctuate greatly from season to season, so no hard and fast rules can be set on the format of the trials

Attending trials

A player must give the Senior/Junior Coordinator/s as much notice as possible if they cannot attend a trial for any reason.

Date: 25/7/2023

Acceptable, valid reasons for not attending a trial/s are at the discretion of the committee before offering a place to a player.

If weather cancels a trial an alternate date will be booked if possible.
