This is my second year as Treasurer of HSSC Incorporated and it's been another challenging one. The Club has gone through a lot of changes, and we have made progress in the way we prepare reports and financial information to the BOM.

We are working though our "One Club" goal.

All the sections are contribute towards a successful club.

Our aim is to keep the club financially viable as well as connecting with the local community to be part of our growing club.

We are looking at different ways of spending money to improve our facilities and help our sports clubs improve the way they operate. We have put up new lights and they have been an asset to the club.

Our next major project is the resurfacing of the tennis and netball courts. We have received a grant for this and the council will also assist with funding the project. We are also working on our 5 year plan for the Club.
