Membership

Eligibility

Categories of Membership

<u>Associate Members:</u> Individuals who support the club but do not participate regularly. They do not have voting rights.



Governance

Basketball Committee

The Basketball Committee shall consist of the following roles. Committee members may hold more than one (1) role.

- Chairperson
- Communications coordinator
- Coach coordinator
- Age group coordinator
- Member Protection Officer
- Child Protection Officer
- General Members

Duties of Officers

- Chairperson: Provides overall leadership, presides over meetings, and represents the club.
- Coach coordinator: Provides support to coaches throughout the season, via meetings, feedback, and induction
- **Age Coordinators:** Provides support with team placement, management of teams during the season and placement concerns.
- **Communications Coordinator:** Provides clear and timely communication between The Club and members through platforms including, newsletters, website and social media. Supports the Chairperson to maintain Club records.
- **Member Protection Officer:** Provides information about a person's rights, responsibilities, and options to an individual making a complaint or raising a concern, is the 1st point of call for members.
- **Child Protection Officer:** Is responsible for ensuring the Club follows safeguarding children procedures. Responding to complaints or reports of child abuse and inducting volunteers with child safe practices.

Meetings

Regular Meetings

Regular meetings shall be held monthly at a time and place determined by the Chairperson.

Special Meetings

Special meetings may be called by the Chairperson or any three active members with at least seven days' notice to all members.
